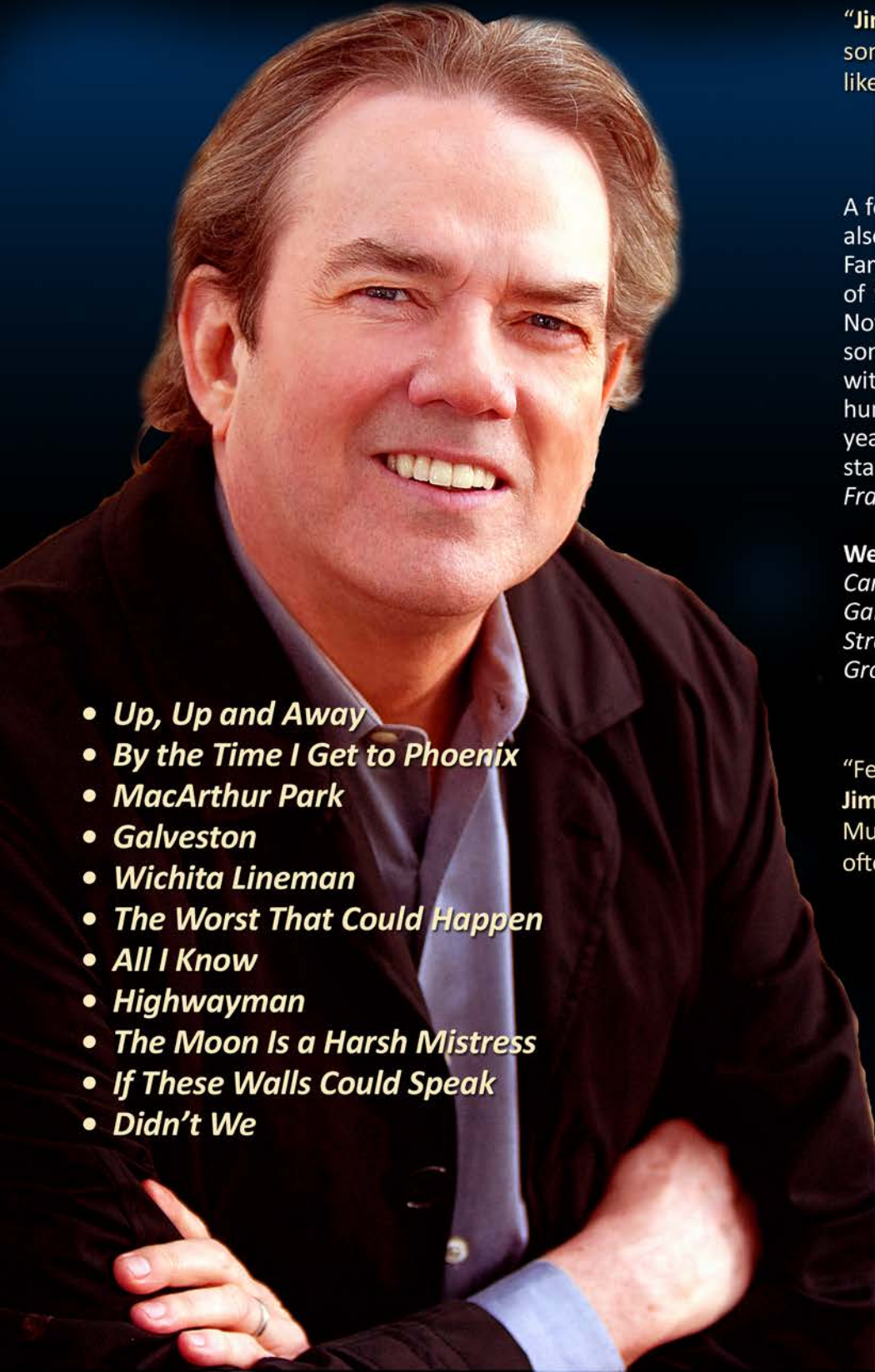




JIMMY WEBB
