

Workshop Offerings

Improv Workshop - Basic or advanced Improv technique based on students level of experience. Students will learn beginning improv structure, theories, and styles. Theatre games, group exercises, performance ideas, and scene work.

Clowning & Physical Comedy - The workshop will focus on basic gag structure such as the rule of three's, surprise, and change of status - as well as a number of of bits of physical comedy - double takes, trips, hair pulls, slaps, foot stomps, etc. Participants will then create their own short gag using the techniques they have learned.

Shakespeare - Members of the acting company will conduct a class covering the basics of verse, discussed from the standpoint of an actor analyzing the text. Participants will recite passages from various Shakespearean sources to gain familiarity with the language, and learn how to use iambic pentameter to decipher the action in a scene, with particular emphasis on level appropriate exercises.

Audition Workshop - RSC members conduct an Audition Workshop giving generally audition tips and coaching individual students on monologues that the students have previously memorized for classes or auditions.
