Sons of Mystro has been honing their skills in the Broward County public school system, attending Bethune Elementary School in Hollywood, Florida, on through Parkway Middle School, Ft. Lauderdale, Florida, Dillard High School for the Performing Arts and Broward College, Davie, Florida.

Since forming in 2010, Sons of Mystro have become one of the most innovative violin duos of their generation, seamlessly blending classical technique with contemporary genres including reggae, R&B, hip-hop, and pop. Over the past several years, they have performed at premier festivals and cultural institutions such as the Ann Arbor Folk Festival, the International Festival of Arts & Ideas, SunFest, the New Haven Festival, and the Beloved Community Awards, solidifying their position at **the intersection of classical virtuosity and modern cultural relevance.**
